The occupational health research units in the western and northern part of Denmark have combined their resources and capabilities into a new collaborating research centre with the aim of developing and expanding the research into preventable

strong spirit of dedication to fuel open-minded and dynamic research, to the benefit of working people in Denmark and throughout the world.

The working environment has changed dramatically since Ramazzini's time, and many serious occupational hazards have successfully been eliminated in affluent countries. The research strategy of the new centre acknowledges this favourable development and will focus its activities on new challenges of modern working life, such as psychosocial workplace factors, the importance of low-level exposure to chemicals and particles in early critical phases of life, and unsolved paradoxes related to musculoskeletal complaints, sickness absence and return to work.

At the opening ceremony on April 24th, Professor Philippe Grandjean spoke on behalf of the Collegium Ramazzini about the great magister from Carpi, and he presented a book – the European Journal of Oncology's Ramazzini biography – to the founding director, Professor Jens Peter Bonde.
