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Progress in Nutrition has generously accepted to publish these abbreviated Proceedings of the 4<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Functional Foods 'New Horizons in Chinese Medicines & Health Foods' that took place on October 29-30, 2009 at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University.
